

Chainsaw + Forklift Operator

This position will contain two parts in the work day cutting engineered wood products and operating a forklift safely while loading or unloading orders. While operating the forklift, loads can range up to 60 feet in length.

ESSENTIAL DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES include but not limited to:

- Cutting engineered wood products with chainsaw in a safe manner, with minimum waste
- Build loads with accuracy of all lumber grades
- Assemble and band loads together
- Adhere to safe workplace policies, procedures, and safety standards
- Responsible for meeting productivity requirements in a safe and efficient manner
- Stock bins with designated lumber products
- Operating forklift to inspect, tally and put credits away, sort timber and load checking

- Current forklift certification for the worksite
- Ability to operate a chainsaw in a safe manner
